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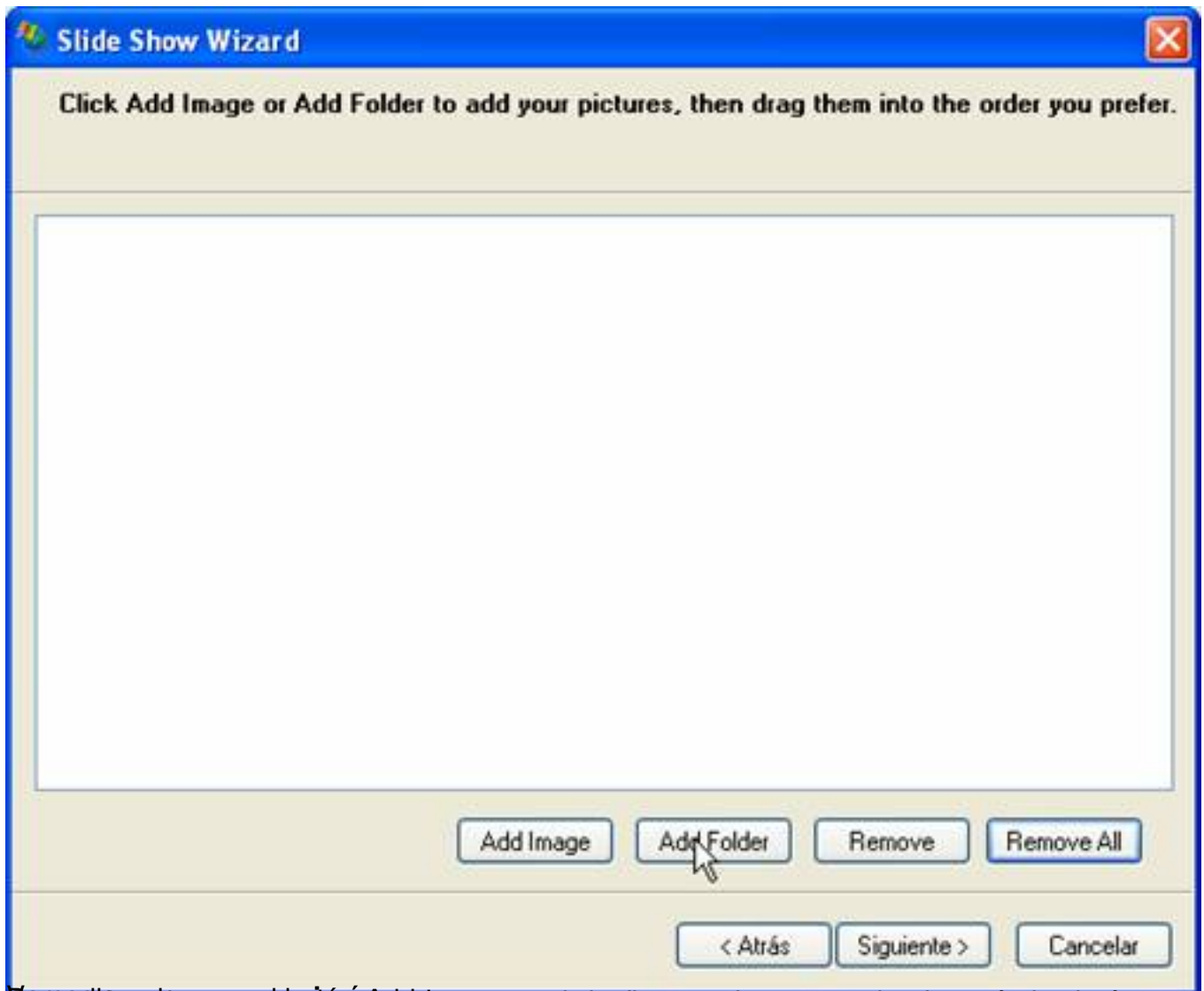
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Si pulasamos en Siguiente, aparece la segunda ventana.

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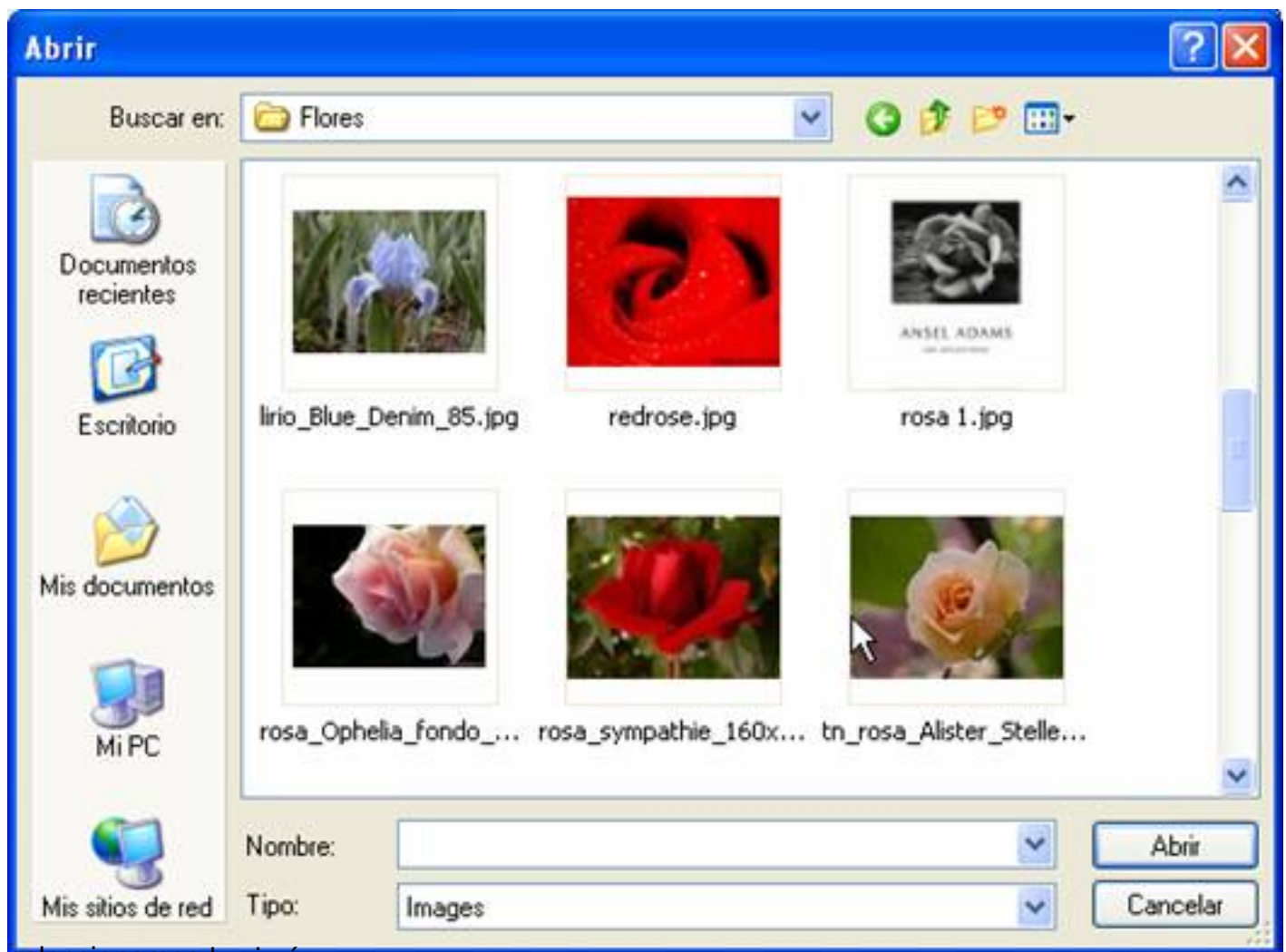

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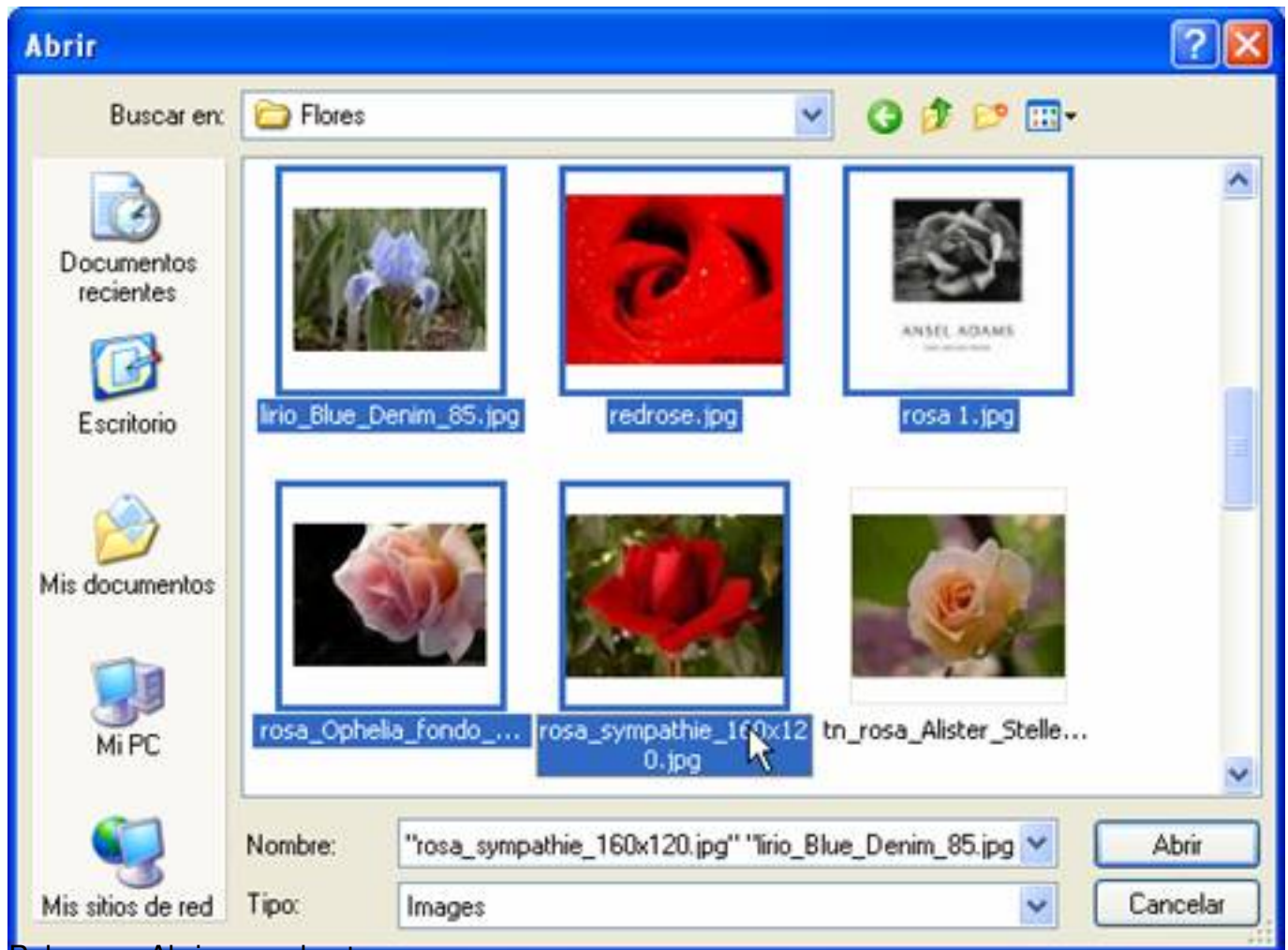
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seleccionamos las imágenes que queramos,

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Pulsamos Abrir y nos las trae:

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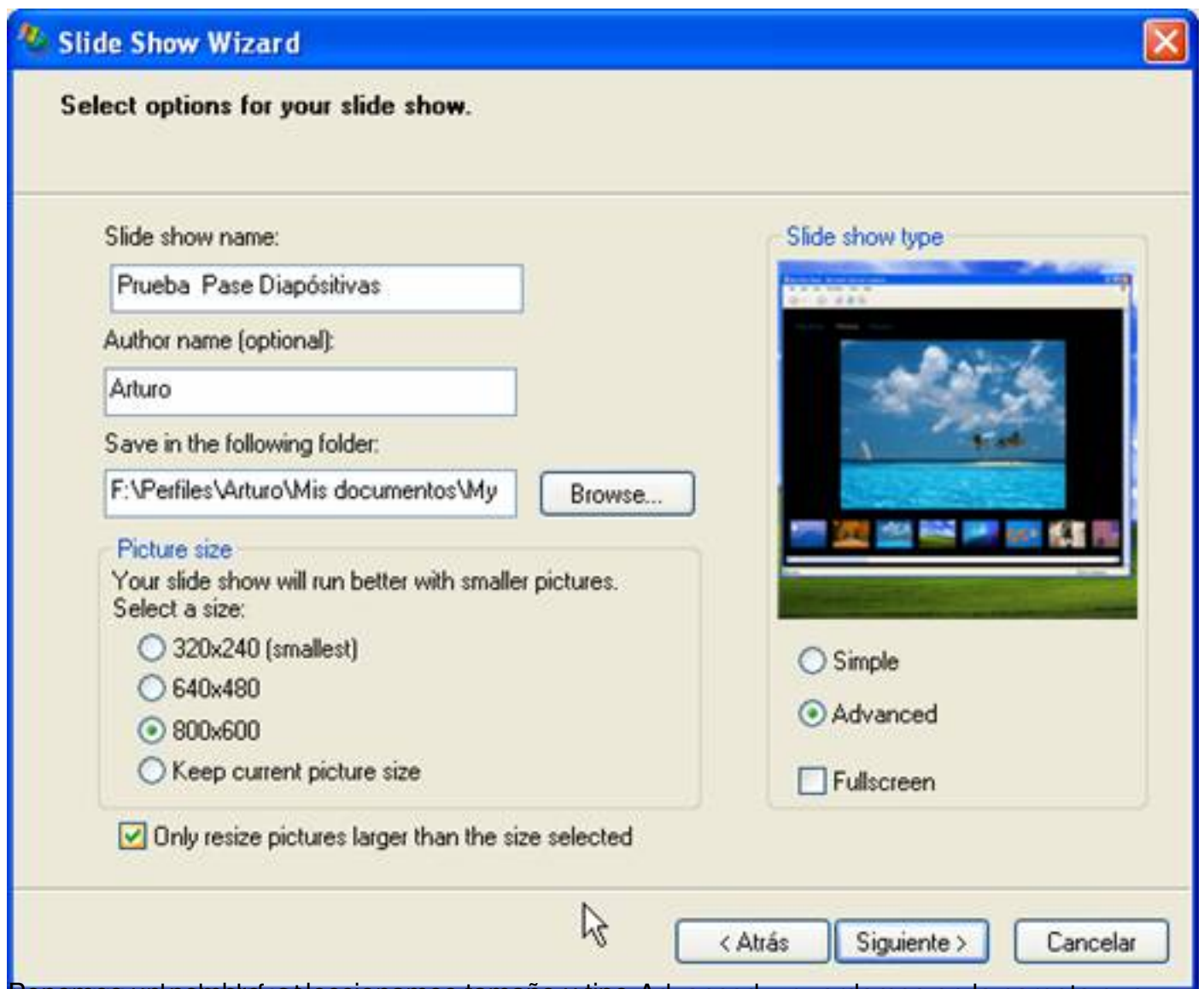
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Pulsamos Siguiete, y nos sale la pantalla:

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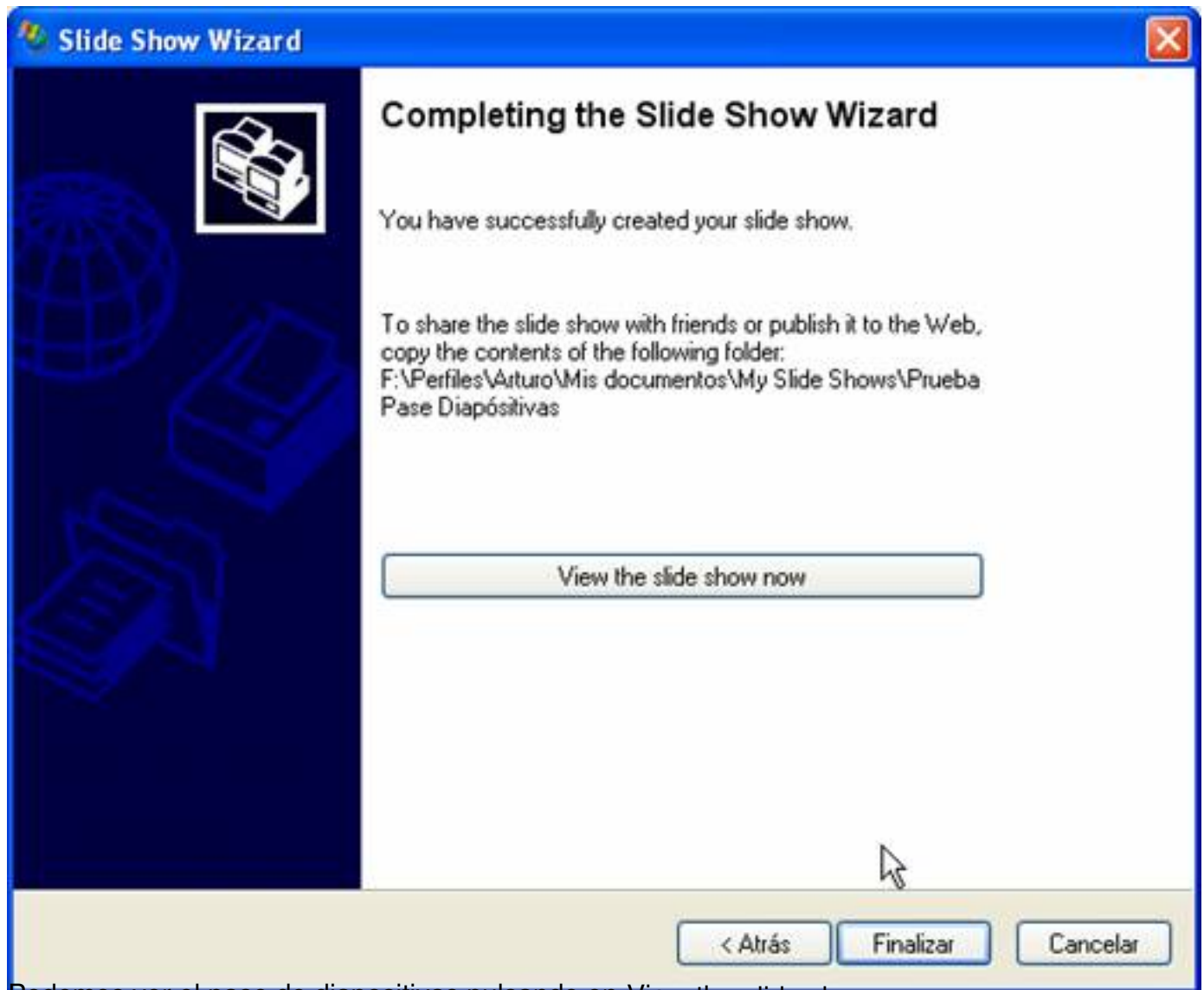
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Por último, en la opción de tamaño y tipo seleccionamos tamaño y tipo Advanced y guardamos en la carpeta que queremos o la default.

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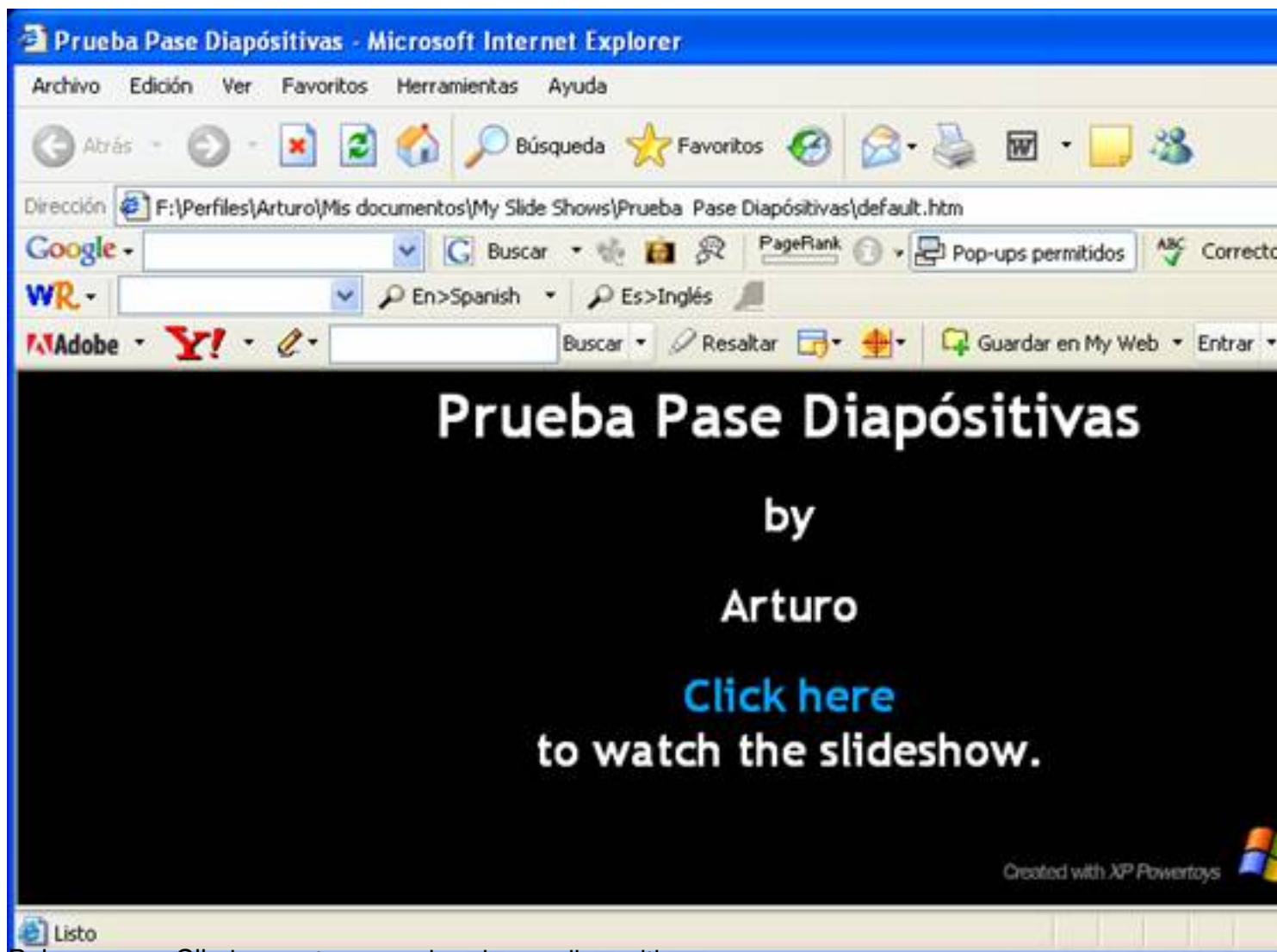
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Podemos ver el pase de diapositivas pulsando en View the slide show now:

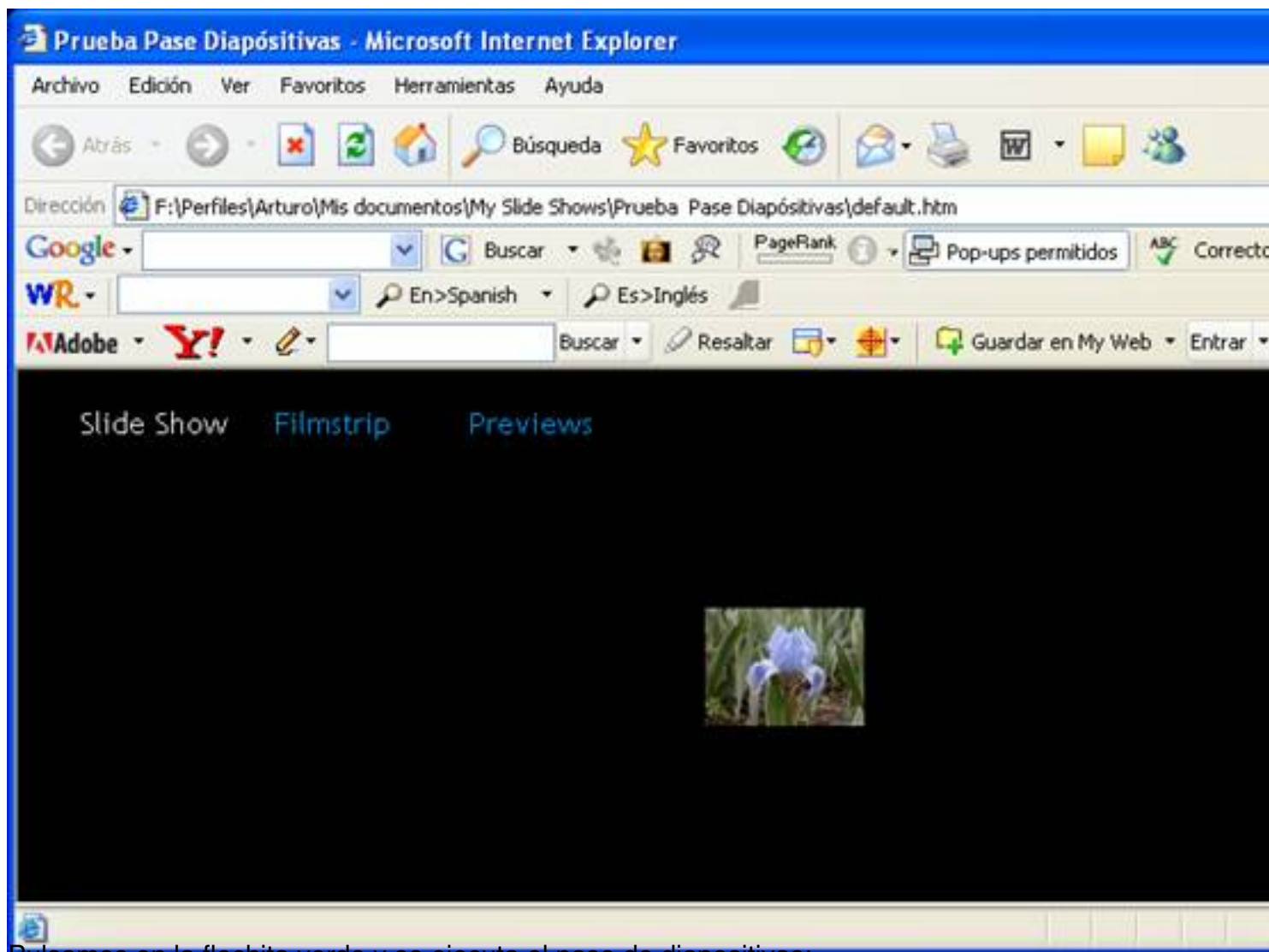
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Pulsamos en Clic here y tenemos la primera diapositiva:

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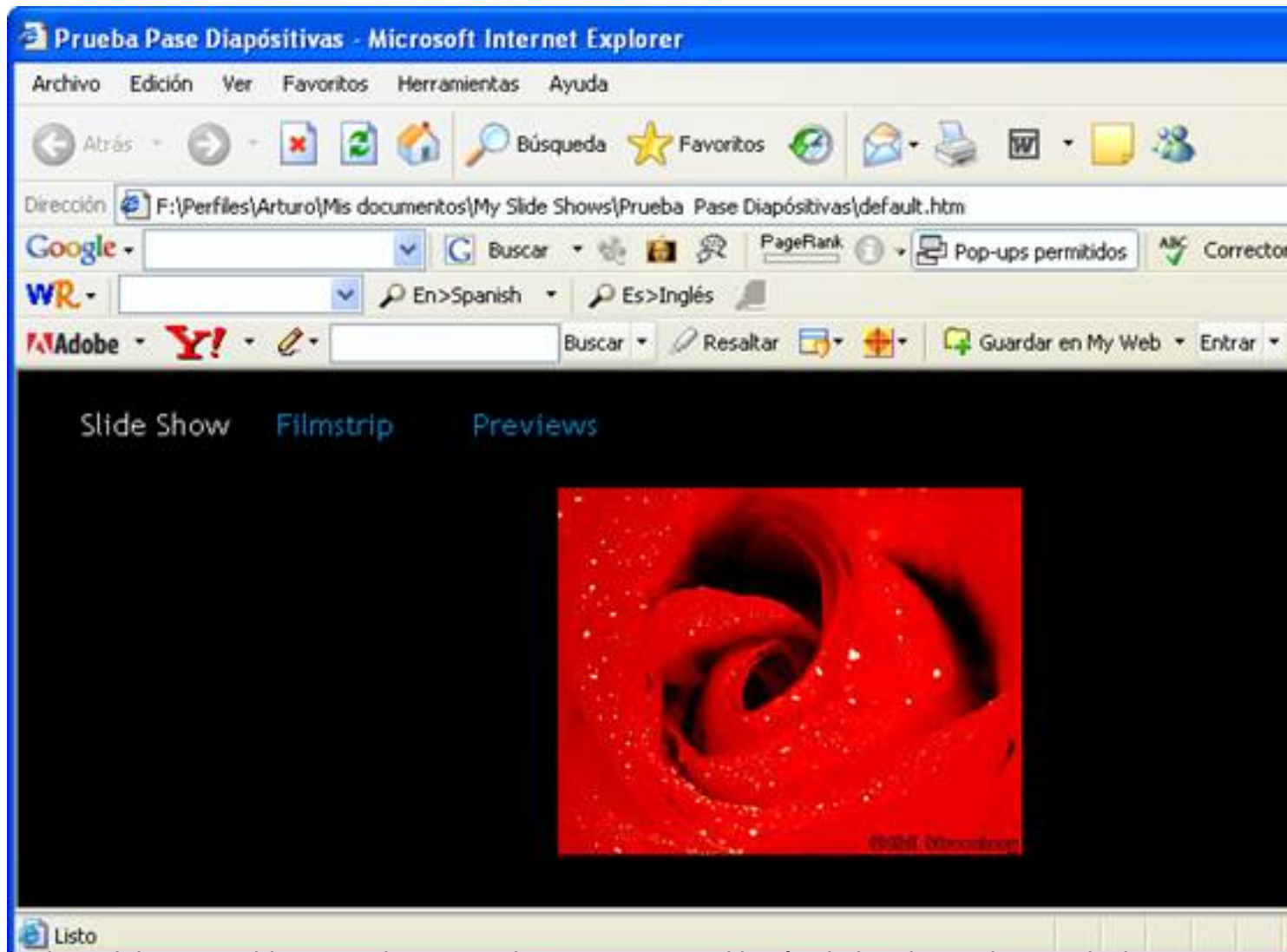
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Pulsamos en la flechita verde y se ejecuta el pase de diapositivas:

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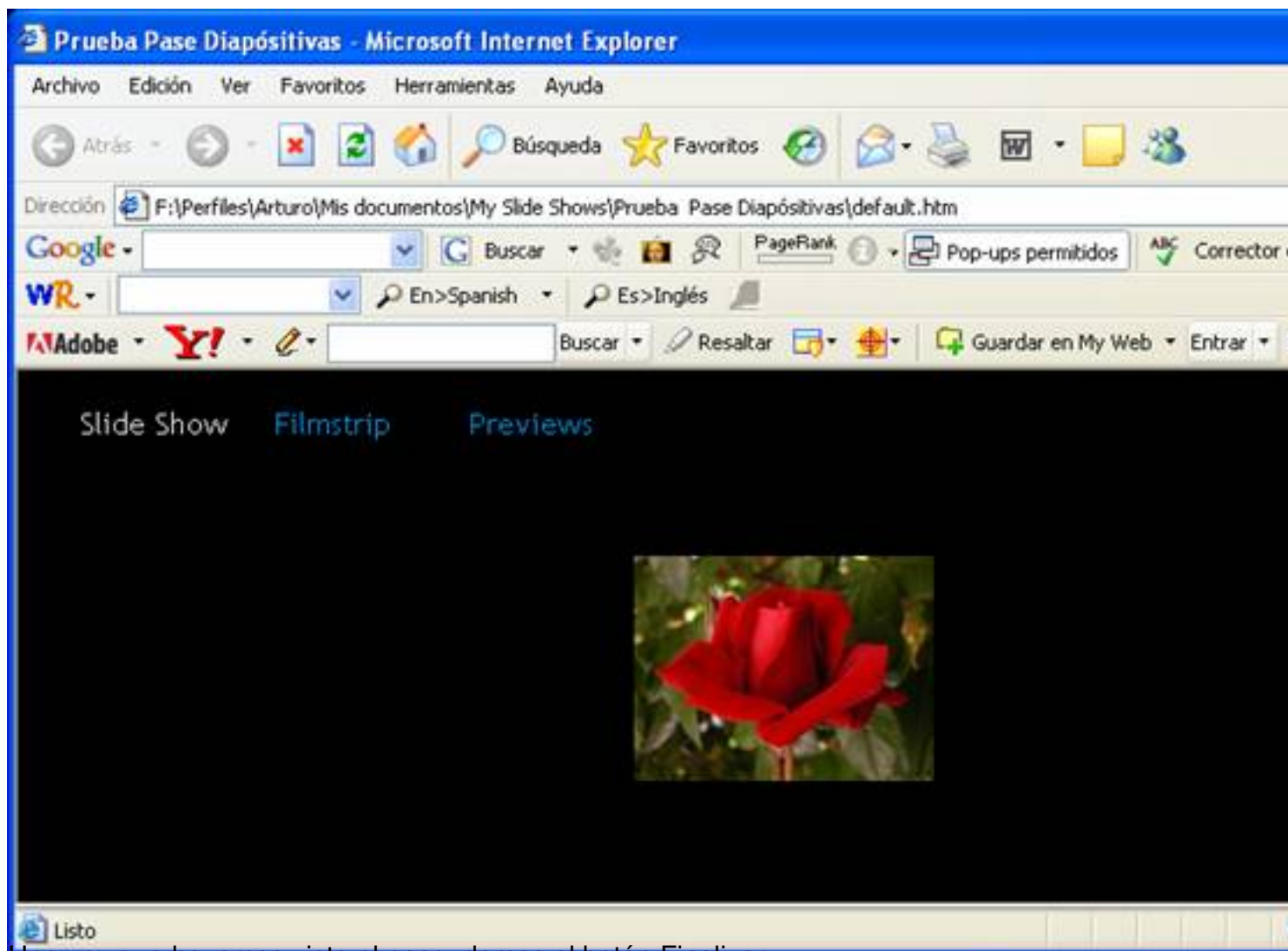
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Lo hace ininterrumpidamente, hasta que lo paremos con el botón de las dos rayitas verticales.

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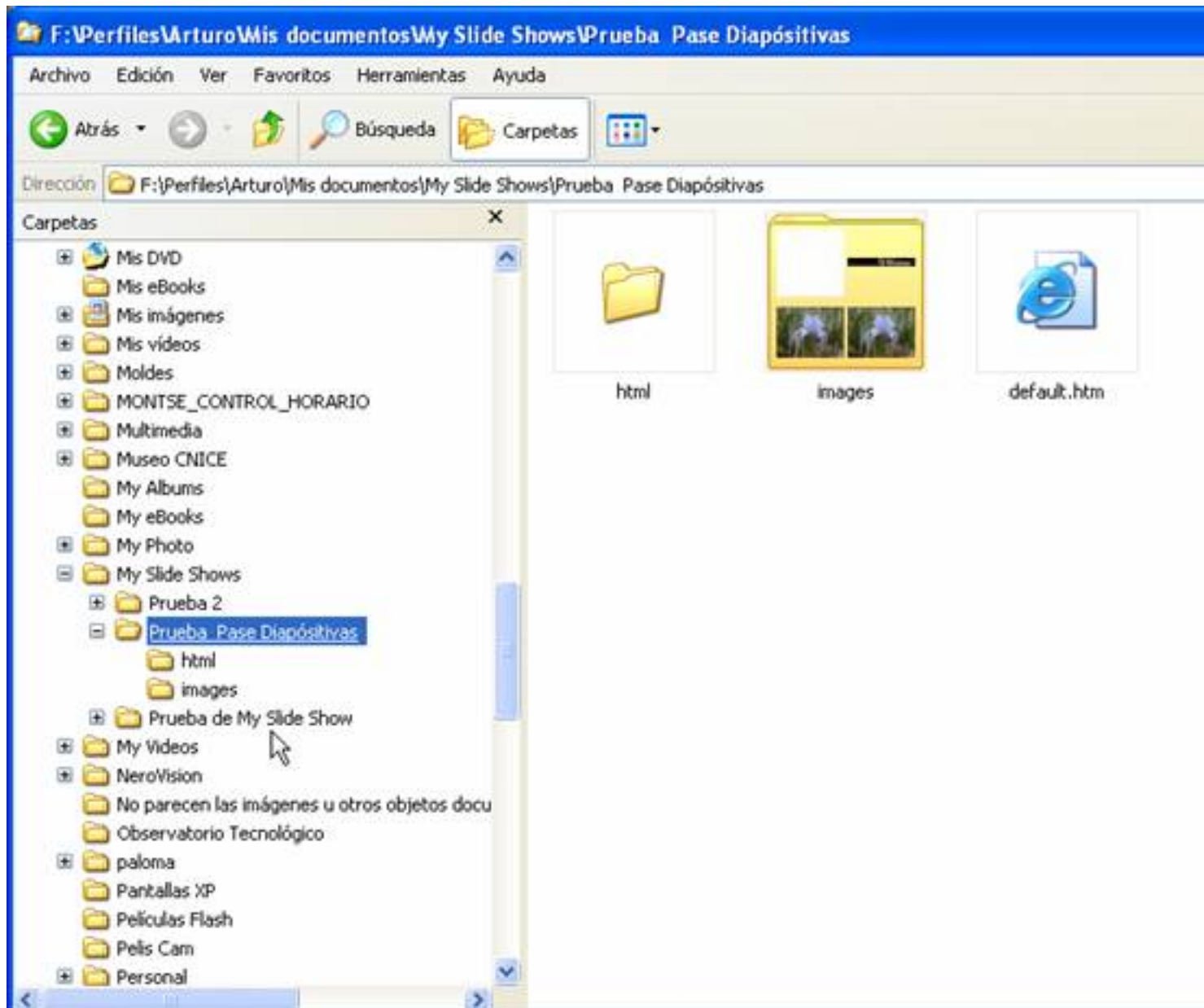
Una vez que hayamos visto el pase, damos al botón Finalizar.

se ha creado una carpeta llamada Prueba Pase Diapositivas.

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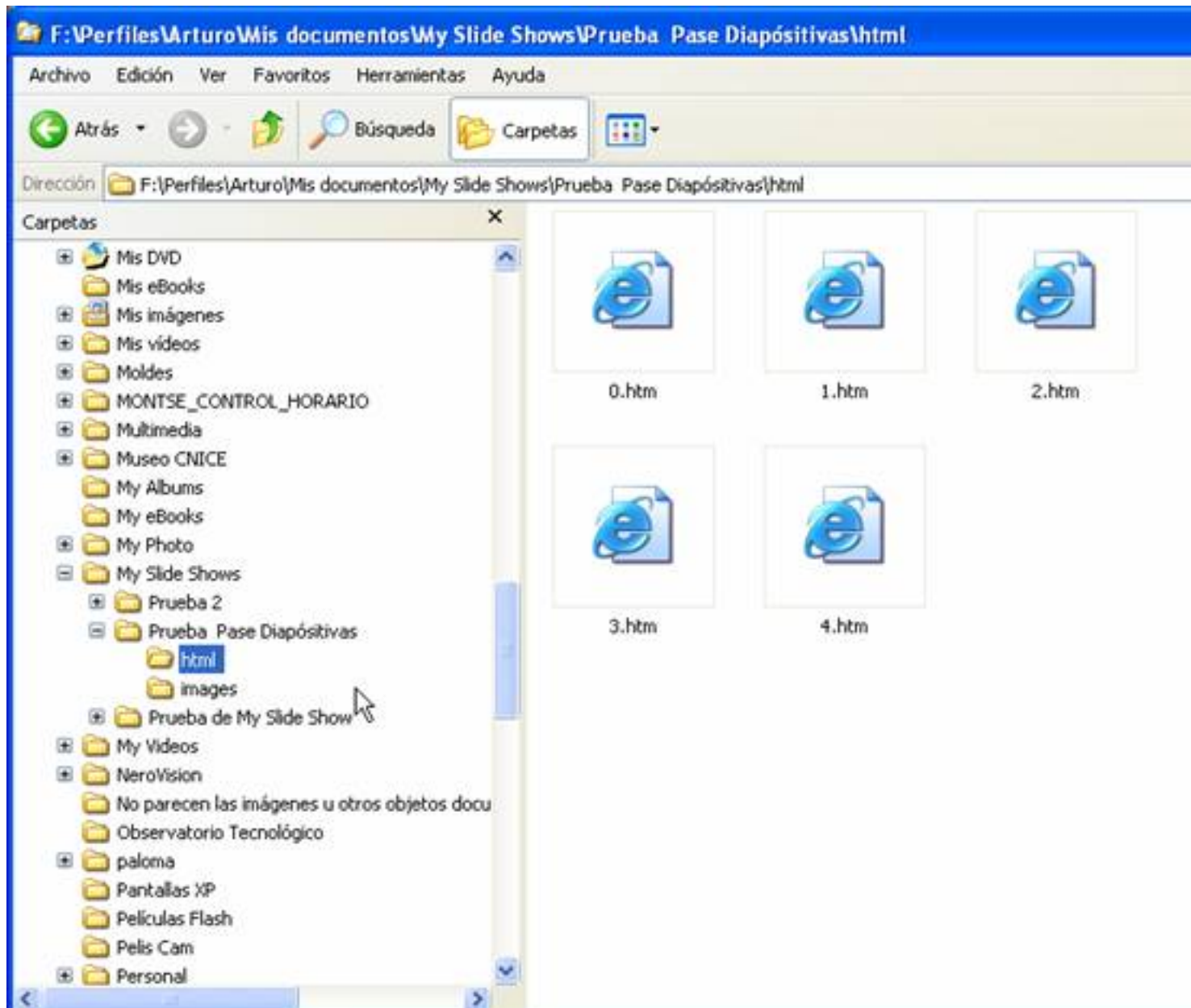

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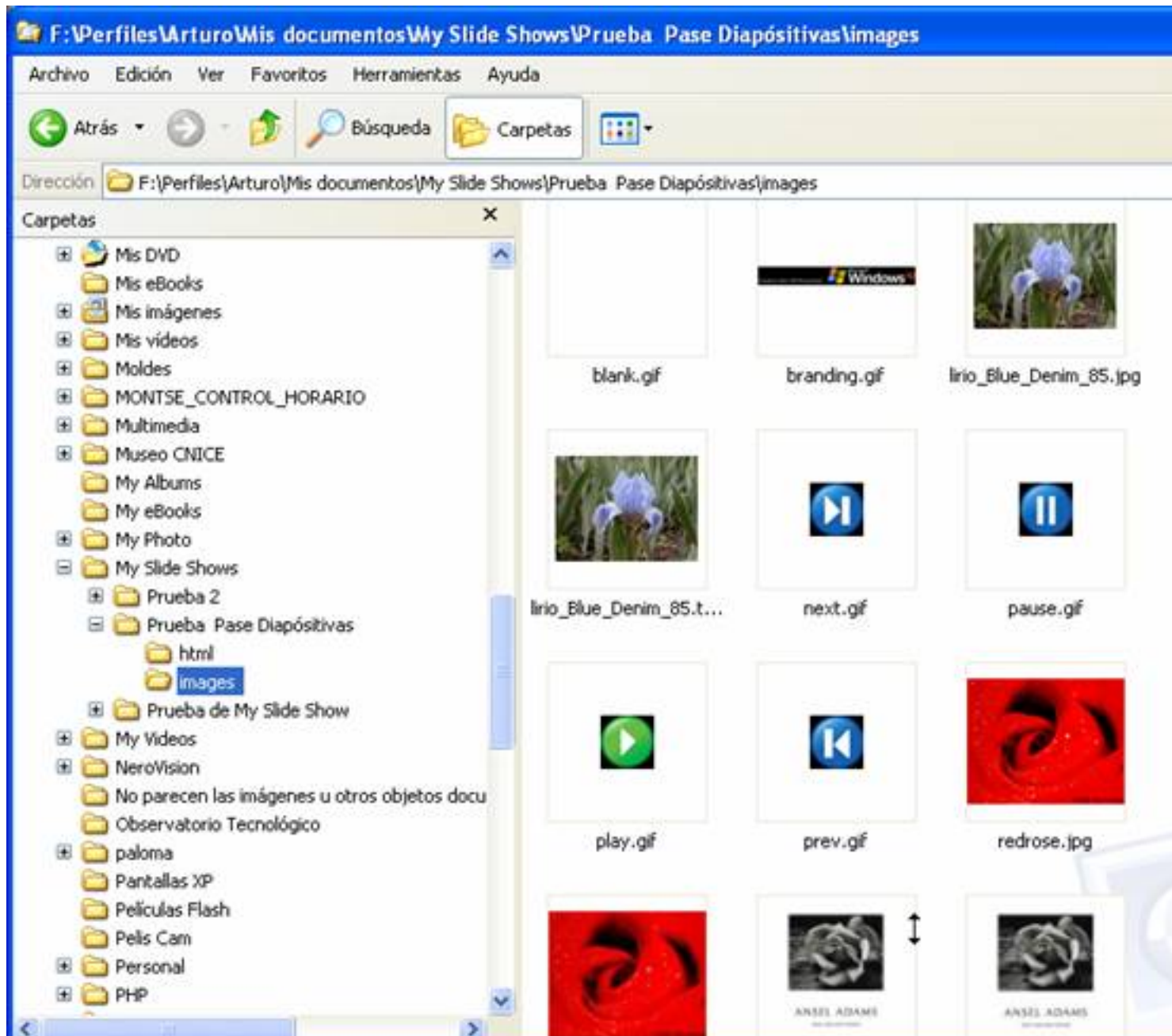
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La otra carpeta, **images**, contiene las imágenes que usan las páginas html.
